BUSINESS MEETING -- PLEASANT HILL BAPTIST CHURCH – JANUARY 13, 2008

The Pleasant Hill Baptist Church met for the monthly business meeting on Sunday, January 13, 2008. Bro. Bill called the meeting to order. Mike Duncan opened with prayer. Karen Bond made a motion to approve the minutes of the last meeting (November, 2007) as printed. Motion carried.

Deacons – Mike Duncan reported that they are looking at the church roll and want to be more consistent. If people do not attend, the resident members will be made inactive; the non-resident members will be removed.

Joe Ford said he wanted to resign as Chairman of Deacons since he could not attend the meetings. The motion was made to elect Butch Bray as Chairman of Deacons as he was next in line. Motion carried.
