

BUSINESS MEETING -- PLEASANT HILL BAPTIST CHURCH – JULY 13, 2008

Pastor's Report – Several visits were made during the month. Bro. Bill said he was cautiously optimistic. He wants to increase opportunities for the youth – float trip, Worlds of Fun, and next year involve them in a mission trip. Two boys went to camp.

Bro. Bill would like for us to have a 24-hour prayer vigil for Jon Thomann and family and asked for a volunteer to organize it. He thought the Family Fun Fair had a very positive impact on the community, and we had some visitors in the worship service as a result.

Nominating Committee Report – JoAnn Looten presented the recommendations for 2008-2009 (see attached list). Joe Ford seconded the recommendation from the committee. Motion carried.

Family Fun Fair – Bro. Bill thought everything was simpler this year. Since he was not involved in a band, he was able to have more interaction with those in attendance. He thanked everyone for all their work.

Bro. Bill encouraged us to help meet the needs of those around us with whom we come in contact.
