

BUSINESS MEETING - PLEASANT HILL BAPTIST CHURCH – July 8, 2007

The Pleasant Hill Baptist Church met for the monthly business meeting on Sunday, July 8, 2007. Bro. Bill called the meeting to order.

Karen Bond made a motion to approve the minutes of the last meeting as printed. Pam Duncan seconded. Motion carried.

JoAnn Looten made a motion to approve the treasurer's report as printed. Motion seconded and carried. Brenda Bray, treasurer, said she put all the Family Fun Fair expenses under Vacation Bible School.

The clerk had nothing to report.

JoAnn reported for the trustees that FAB gave them a couple of bids – one was \$8,120.57, the other was \$9,000 plus. This does not include pulling up the old carpet. The old bid from Lepper's was \$12,000 less \$1,000 for moving the furniture. We talked about putting tile in the downstairs area, but Mike Duncan said this would be more expensive because there would be a ton of prep work. Bro. Bill said we should commit this matter to prayer for one month and see how God leads us..

Karen Bond reported an average attendance in Sunday School of 20 for June and a high of 23.

The Women on Mission had three at the July meeting.

Bro. Bill said he went to Promise Keepers last year and would like to take some men this year. He did not make any hospital visits, but had two meetings each week—Family Fun Fair, Band practice, and the Nominating Committee. He said he appreciated all the work everyone is doing for the Fair.

The expenses for the Fair were estimated to be \$1000 to \$1200 to include sound equipment rental, clowns, Block Party trailer, food, puppets, musicians, etc. Peggy Falk made a motion to approve this as a reasonable cost. Motion seconded and carried.

Old Business: The nominating committee is functioning. Consider what God wants you to do.

Brother Bill said no church can grow without focusing on children's ministry.

The CCLI license has not been obtained yet.

The nursery was discussed and it was suggested we hire someone. Brenda will put up a signup sheet again. Pam suggested we get a list of people willing to help. Emily is doing ages 2-6 extended session.

New Business: The answering machine is not working very well. Karen Bond made a motion that we get a new one. Since it will be less than \$50, it was referred to the Trustees. No vote.

Bill will look at doing an August or September youth event. In October he would like to have a missionary here. He would also like to plan a Thanksgiving dinner and a Christmas event.

Joe Ford made the motion to adjourn.
