

BUSINESS MEETING -- PLEASANT HILL BAPTIST CHURCH – JUNE 8, 2008

The deacons did not meet, but plan to meet the second Wednesday in July.

Butch Bray made a motion to approve the reports and JoAnn seconded.

The Family Fun Fair is scheduled for June 21. Things are falling into place.
