

BUSINESS MEETING - PLEASANT HILL BAPTIST CHURCH - MAY 6, 2007

The Pleasant Hill Baptist Church met for the monthly business meeting on Sunday, May 6, 2007. Bro. Bill called the meeting to order and asked Joe Ford to lead in prayer.

The minutes of the last meeting were approved as printed. Joe Ford made a motion to approve the treasurer's report as printed.

The clerk asked about the pastor's membership.

JoAnn Looten, chairman of trustees, said Edith Jeffries donated a refrigerator with an ice maker to the church. Mel worked on the ice maker this morning as it was leaking. It needs a washer. The water in the basement on Wednesday was caused from the large hose/pipe not being attached to the downspout. Therefore, the water drained down next to the foundation. Thanks to Chip Lindley who brought his shopvac up and cleaned up the water.

JoAnn had samples of some carpet for the church, although she said we may need to do something different in the basement. She also had checked on a new copier, and we can get a Canon for \$125. Holly Johnson made a motion to buy this copier. Motion carried.

Sunday School -- Some changes were discussed in the recent church council meeting. Bro. Bill would like to return to a fellowship atmosphere downstairs and have 4 or 5 teams (or rotate classes) to bring refreshments before class. Announcements could be done at the same time. Bible study class would be from 9:45 - 10:35. Vicky Thomann made the motion to add the fellowship/announcement time and start with oldest class bringing refreshments. Motion seconded and carried.

Rose Callahan reported the Women on Mission made and delivered 9 Mother's Day baskets to the Samaritan Center.

Baptist Men had no report.

The pastor reported he made 2 visits, 5 phone calls, and sent 4 post cards. He said some changes are being made at work.

The motion was made and carried to approve the reports.

Old Business: Instead of having VBS, we discussed doing a family fair with games, a band on a trailer, jumping pit, brochure, and meal/food. We have 4 to 6 weeks to prepare. JoAnn made a motion to have a Family Fun Fair this summer. Motion carried. Volunteers for committee: Virginia, Vicky, JoAnn, Rose, Bro. Bill.

Joe Ford asked about using the \$22,000 we have in the bank and said it should not just lay there. It was suggested we come back at the next meeting and discuss ways the Lord wants us to use His money.

New Business: Bro. Bill would like for us to obtain a CCLI license to be able to sing and copy new songs. The cost is \$105 per year. Joe Ford made a motion that we do this. Motion seconded and carried.

Bro. Bill said Brenda and Emily have talked about having an extended service and nursery. Would like for the church to authorize the beginning of children's church downstairs for ages 3 to 6 or 7. This would start with the offering time. Rose made a motion that we proceed with this ministry. Virginia seconded. Motion carried.

There was discussion of moving the nursery to the north room and possibly cut a window in the wall between there and the auditorium. The chairman of the trustees (JoAnn) will check on the cost and

size of doing this. Virginia made a motion to move the nursery and check on the window. Vicky seconded. Motion carried.

Joe Ford made the motion to adjourn.
