

## **BUSINESS MEETING -- PLEASANT HILL BAPTIST CHURCH -- NOVEMBER 11, 2009**

The Pleasant Hill Baptist Church met for the monthly business meeting on Wednesday, November 11, 2009. Bro. Bill called the meeting to order. Mike Duncan made a motion to approve the minutes of the last meeting. Motion seconded and carried.

**Treasurer's Report** -- Brenda Bray presented the Treasurer's report. A motion was made, seconded and carried to approve the Treasurer's report.

**Clerk's Report** -- The clerk stated that Ashley Gibson had come on profession of faith for baptism.

**Trustee's Report** -- Peggy asked if anyone had some floor lamps to donate for use with the youth in the parsonage.

**Sunday School Report** -- JoAnn reported a high of 34 and low of 29 in September with average of 31. October had a high of 35 and a low of 24 with an average of 31. A new Sunday School class was created for those not able to navigate the stairs. They had a promotion on November 1 for high attendance Sunday and reached the goal of 50 attendees. The Sunday School records indicated an attendance of 51 that day. We "pied" the pastor for reaching our goal.

**Women on Mission** -- Rose reported that two life boxes were made for military persons. Cookies were made for the BSU, and coats and caps were collected for the Boys and Girls Club and the Samaritan Center.

**Baptist Men** -- Mike Campbell said the campout was cancelled because of the weather.

**Deacons' Report** -- The deacon's are working with the outreach director and inreach.

**Pastor's Report** -- Carleen's funeral, several members in the hospital 8-10 visits. Youth group has about 12 on Wednesday night. He is not teaching the adults now so he can be with the youth. Has been busy with his other job.

**Children's Department** -- Pam said they had a fantastic Halloween party.

The **church council** met in November, but will not meet in December. Business meeting will be held in January. The next church council meeting will be in February.

Peggy Falk made a motion to approve the reports. Pam Duncan seconded. Motion carried.

**Concord Association Meeting** -- Mel Callahan reported on the association semi-annual meeting. A new program called GPS is to include a survey of our area. We are to pray walk or drive the area and hang plastic bags on the door knobs with information about our church and a tract. Cost will be 6 cents for the bag and tract. There are 3.4 million people in Missouri without Jesus.

**Missouri Baptist Convention** -- Most are aware of the split over the Missouri Baptist Foundation, Baptist Home, Missouri Baptist College and Windermere. At the last MBC Annual Meeting, it was voted that CP money will be used for the lawsuits unless we notify the MBC that we want to go for Option B. Peggy Falk made a motion that we go with option B which states that our money would not go for the lawsuits. Mike Duncan seconded. Motion carried.

**The proposed budget for 2010** was presented. The pastor's salary will remain the same at his and Emily's request. Last year when he was laid off, the church helped them. This year, God has blessed them greatly. We will vote on the budget in January.

The goal for LMCO was set at \$1100 with a hallelujah goal of \$1300. Mel made a motion to approve these goals. Gertie seconded. Motion carried.
