

BUSINESS MEETING -- PLEASANT HILL BAPTIST CHURCH – OCTOBER 12, 2008

The Pleasant Hill Baptist Church met for the monthly business meeting on Sunday, October 12, 2008. Bro. Bill called the meeting to order. Peggy Falk made a motion to approve the minutes as printed. The motion was seconded by Virginia Lindley. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report -- The motion was made by Mel Callahan to approve the treasurer's report. The motion was seconded by Gertie Jeffries. Motion carried.

Clerk's Report – Nothing to Report.

Trustee's Report -- Mel Callahan reported on the work done on the parsonage which included ordering window well for basement, planting mums, cleaning windows and blinds, replacing vinyl in kitchen, repairing water damaged ceiling in bedroom and installing blue carpet, new vinyl in hall bath, entry way prepared for varnish, basement window removed and replaced with metal plate and dryer vent, some water and drain lines checked and repaired, painting and repairs done in hall closet and middle bedroom. Some additional work is still to be done.

Sunday School Report – The Sunday School average attendance was 21 for August and 33 for September.

Women on Mission – The women met at Holly Johnson's home. An offering for World Hunger is being collected in October as well as food for the Samaritan Center. Shoe boxes for Samaritan's Purse will be the emphasis in November.

Baptist Men – The men and boys are planning a campout at Mike Campbell's on October 24-25.

Pastor's Report – Bro. Bill reported 5 personal visits and a lot of phone conversations. There are lots of needs and some answered prayers. God is working. It is a good time to invite people to church.

Deacon's Meeting – The deacons did not meet.

Church Council Meeting – The Church Council met and calendared events through February, including a Thanksgiving dinner, choir program, Emily family singing, and PHBC 500. The concrete pad was discussed.

Semi-Annual Association Meeting – Bro. Bill said the focus was on missions. A new discipleship initiative is being implemented (seminary-type classes).

Old Business – The lapel mic will cost a minimum of \$300 to replace. Mel made a motion for the worship committee to check into this and find one for \$300-\$600. Mike Duncan seconded. Motion carried.

The concrete pad was discussed. Money is available to do it now. Volleyball size is 30 X 60 and basketball is 45 X 50.

Butch Bray said we need to have a budget committee meeting and make a recommendation at the November business meeting.

Peggy Falk said we need to provide funds for the Wednesday night supper and Sunday morning breakfast as Gertie and JoAnn have been doing this. Both events have grown in attendance. This was discussed and agreed that these expenses should be turned in to the church.
